On the Program:

Niagara Gorge Restoration Project and Site Tour

Dave Spiering, Conservation Project Manager, will present on the Western New York Land Conservancy's Niagara Gorge Restoration Project, a multi-year project of invasive species control and ecological restoration on state-owned lands in the Niagara Gorge. The project includes extensive control of woody species in an effort to improve native plant community diversity. Target species include Norway maple, bush honeysuckle and *Phragmites*. After the presentation, we will drive the short distance to the project site, where we will see the restoration efforts in progress, and gain a great sense of the overall scale of the project.
