
It is recommended someone assist you when putting on the EAB Costume

Step 1

Step into the gray under-armor. Once your feet and arms are through the holes, you will need to Velcro the back shut. There are three Velcro straps that can be fed through adjacent holes.


Optional

Wings: The wings have Velcro straps that feed through the back of the gray under-armor. Put on the wings before you move onto Step 2.



Step 2

Step into the green overcoat part of the costume. Be sure that the gray under-armor's "tail" feeds into the "tail sleeve" attached to the green overcoat. Close by wrapping the Velcro waist strap around your waist. Then proceed to lay the wing sheaths down your back, this part of the costume will also have to be Velcroed shut.




Step 3

Put on the helmet and collar. Be sure to have the Velcroed side of the collar facing forward.

The EAB Costume comes with a face mask as well. It is a black cloth that fully encloses around your head.
