Americorps Program Overview



Spotted Lanternfly Management

Thom Allgaier, Invasive Species Coordinator, NYS Department of Agriculture & Markets. Spotted lanternfly was first discovered in Pennsylvania in 2014, found in NYS in 2020, and more recently was found in Erie County. Learn about management actions that have taken place across the state and here in western New York, and how we can be prepared should more infestations be found.
